



Safety is always Skydive Saskatoon's top priority. With that, the owners of Skydive Saskatoon are working in relation with the Saskatchewan Health Authority, WorkSafe Saskatchewan, Transport Canada, the Canadian Sport Parachuting Association, skydiving equipment manufacturers as well as provincial and federal regulators to make the skydiving experience as safe as possible for staff and participants alike.

All patrons are asked to arrive at their scheduled time slot. Upon arrival, all participants will be asked to complete a 'Health Check Questionnaire' and have their temperature taken prior to entering the hangar.

Spectators are not permitted to enter the hangar. All spectators will be asked to remain in their vehicle and/or sit in the designated outdoor seating areas. Social distancing and groups no larger than 30 people, per provincial guidelines, should be followed.

Staff will be cleaning 'high touch areas' including but not limited to the check in desk, skydiving equipment and airplane, prior to opening and throughout the day. Operations will be halted and additional deep cleaning and disinfection will be conducted if someone is suspected to be infected and/or becomes ill.

Everyone will be required to wear a face covering while indoors and when 2 meters of separation is not possible. Skydive Saskatoon recommends all students purchase a tubular bandana (ie. Buff) available at sporting goods stores to use while jumping.

Hand sanitizer stations will be located through out the hangar. All participants are asked to sanitize their hands upon entry to the hangar as well as prior to and after their skydive.

Goggles and other skydiving equipment will be sanitized between use according to industry recommendations.

Jumpsuits will be available for students to use on a first come, first serve basis. Any student wishing to use a jumpsuit should keep their suit for the duration of their visit. Staff will clean used jumpsuits at the end of each jumping day.

For the prompt identification and isolation of sick people, if you or someone you know are showing symptoms, please alert Skydive Saskatoon staff and leave the hangar immediately for self isolation. Call Healthline by dialing 811 for additional directives and testing.
